### **Press Release: Traffic collision, pedestrian injured UPD case # 18-0379**

On February 9<sup>th</sup> at about 4:49 pm, UPD officers were dispatched to the 300 block of North Main Street, on a reported traffic collision. Upon arrival, officers found an unconscious 41-year-old female, lying near the west side curb edge of the street. Also on scene was the vehicle that had collided with the pedestrian, a grey 2010 Infinity SUV, driven by a 56-year-old female out of Ukiah. Local ambulance and fire department personnel arrived, to treat the injured pedestrian. The pedestrian sustained multiple injuries from the collision and was transported by ambulance to Ukiah Valley Medical Center. Due to the extent of those injuries, she was transferred to Santa Rosa Memorial Hospital, via air ambulance. The cause of the collision is still under investigation.
