Press Release: Traffic stop leads to arrest of probationer with firearm

On February 12th at about 3:58 pm, a UPD officer on patrol stopped a tan Toyota Camry for a traffic violation. During the enforcement stop, the Officer identified one of the passengers at Cody Ringler age 26, out of Willits. While speaking with Ringler, the officer suspected he was under the influence of a controlled substance and had him exit the vehicle. A records check revealed that Ringler was on probation and currently out of jail on O.R. (Released from jail on ones own recognizance). During the investigation, Ringler was found to be in possession of a pistol and placed under arrest. Ringler was booked into jail for possession of a firearm when prohibited, committing a felony while on O.R., under the influence of a controlled substance and for violation of his probation. Ringler was booked into county jail.
