

<b>Type</b>	PepperBall TAC-SA Pro launcher and projectiles (Glass breaking projectiles, inert training projectiles and LIVE X duty use projectiles with 5% PAVA powder)
<b>Description</b>	PepperBall is a less-than-lethal solution for law enforcement to de-escalate conflict and resolve situations with the least amount of force. It is versatile and offers a range of solutions for different scenarios. The system provides law enforcement an intermediate option between verbal commands and more lethal alternatives, giving them a choice to raise or lower the amount of force before inflicting bodily harm, giving officers the tactical advantage of time and distance.
<b>Quantity</b>	2-PepperBall TAC-SA Pro launchers/2, 075 projectiles
<b>Capabilities</b>	The TAC-SA PRO launches a variety of different .68 caliber round projectiles using compressed air. The launcher has a direct impact distance of 60 feet and capable or area saturation up to 150 feet.
<b>Expected Lifespan</b>	5-years
<b>Manufacturer's Description</b>	The TAC-SA PRO is a robust semi-automatic launcher, tailored for high-intensity situations such as daily patrol, crowd management and riot-control scenarios. The TAC-SA PRO quickly disperses PepperBall .68 caliber round projectiles across expansive areas, making it a solid tool for operational teams.
<b>Purpose and Authorized Uses</b>	These less-than-lethal projectiles enable officers to incapacitate or deter individuals, and they offer a safer alternative to lethal firearms in situations involving armed individuals, mental distress, or crisis scenarios. The use of this less-lethal option helps reduce the risk of fatality when a more severe response is unnecessary.
