PRESS RELEASE: UPD CASE # 25-0931

Date: 05/05/2025
Location: 1100 block of Airport Park Boulevard, Ukiah, CA
Incident: Fatal Traffic Collision (Vehicle vs. Pedestrian)

On 05/05/2025, at about 3:06 PM, Ukiah Police Department (UPD) Officers were dispatched to a report of a vehicle vs. pedestrian traffic collision that had just occurred in the parking lot of a gas station/convenience store. It was initially reported to be a hit and run, however when UPD Officers arrived they found the involved driver had not left the scene. The pedestrian, an adult female subject, was located lying on the ground in a parking stall in front of the business. Emergency medical personnel were also dispatched to the scene to render aid to the injured female pedestrian.

During their investigation, UPD Officers learned that moments before the collision the pedestrian had stumbled and fallen to the ground. While the female was still laying on the ground, she was subsequently driven into by the driver of the involved vehicle which was attempting to park at the business. The female received serious injuries as a result and was ultimately transported by air ambulance to an out of area trauma center. Later the following morning, UPD was advised that the female had died from her injuries.

This incident is currently under further investigation by UPD Detectives as well as a UPD Traffic Officer specializing in traffic collisions. A determination will be made regarding any potential criminal conduct by the driver involved in this incident.
